



Job Title: Summer Camp Assistant Teacher

Position Overview:

Responsible for assisting the lead summer teacher as needed with the implementation of developmentally- appropriate learning environments that provide hands-on/minds-on explorations of nature and experiences in art, music, literature, and socio-dramatic play through which children can deepen their conceptual understandings of the plant and animal life of River Legacy Parks.

Responsible for assisting Nature School lead teachers with:

- classroom set up and clean up
- gathering and returning supplies, teaching or resource material
- caring for a sick or injured student until a parent picks up the child

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for teaching the number of classes specified in the summer camp teacher contract.
- Responsible for working effectively with River Legacy staff and volunteers. Assume responsibility for tasks as requested and assigned by the Director of Education.
- Assistant Teacher must wear a River Legacy uniform shirt daily and observe all River Legacy Foundation policies and procedures.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited institution
- Elementary Certification and/or Early Childhood Endorsement and pre-school level teaching experience (3-5) years strongly preferred.
- Experience in outdoor education and/or environmental science preferred.
