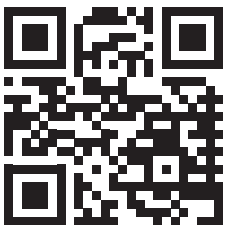

Submission & Release Form:

Qualifications

- All students in Pre-school (ages 3 & 4) through 12th grade in the 2022-2023 school year.
- Winner must be able to pick up prize in person at River Legacy Nature Center.

Specifications

- Original drawing or painting of a Texas native animal and/or plant.
- Artwork may be created with or with a combination of crayons, markers, ink, pencil, charcoal, pastels, oils, acrylics, and watercolor.
- Photography submissions will not be accepted.
- Drawing or painting should be created on an 8.5"x11" white or manila paper.

Submission

- Each artist is required to complete a **Submission & Release Form** for their piece.
- Each individual artist is only allowed ONE entry and the art must be the artist's original work.
- Artwork is required to be submitted electronically by emailing it to **contest@riverlegacy.org** or by filling out the online form at www.riverlegacy.org/art
- Artwork files must be in JPG, JPEG, PNG, or PDF format.

Rubric

There are no rules when it comes to art but please be advised that our judges will be looking at the composition and accuracy of your work when choosing the winners for each category:

Composition

- Is your artwork clearly identifiable?
- Does your artwork include enough detail?

Accuracy

- Is the animal or plant you drew native to Texas?
- Is the animal or plant in your artwork accurate to what it looks like in real life? (color, anatomy, etc.)
