Education:

- **Spring Break Activities** (*Week of March 11-15*)
 - Help our Naturalists facilitate fun environmental education programs for Spring Break families.
- **Summer Camps** (*June-July*)
 - Classroom setup, breakdown, prep lesson materials, and facilitate activities.
- **Front Desk Ambassador** (*Ongoing*)
 - Interact with guests by sharing knowledge about the animals on exhibit, education programs, and the Nature Center.
 - Assist with preparation for various projects throughout the Center.
- **Discovery Room Attendant** (*Seasonal*)
 - Oversee Discovery Room exhibits as needed, greet visitors and offer guidance such as exhibit and Nature Center information.
 - Assist with light cleaning/sanitizing of the Discovery Room.

Community Events:

- **Great Backyard Bird Count** (*Saturday - February 17*)
 - Setup, breakdown, and assist with games and activities for families who visit the center for our annual bird count.
- **Tents & Tales** (*Friday - April 5*)
 - Setup, breakdown, and assist with nature crafts & s'mores as families enjoy a night under the stars.
- **Earth Day Festival** (*Saturday - April 6*)
 - Setup, breakdown, and assist with games and activities to encourage action for a healthy planet.
- **W.A.T.E.R Festival** (*Saturday - September 14*)
 - Setup, breakdown, and assist with games and activities to educate about water conservation.

Environmental:

- **Privet Patrol** (*Saturday - Once a month*)
 - Assist in removing invasive plant species from River Legacy Parks.
- **Trail Cleanup** (*Contact for availability*)
 - Pick up & dispose of trash and debris along the Nature Center trails to help maintain the health of our ecosystem. *Tools and gloves are provided.*
- **Trail Mulching** (*Contact for availability*)
 - Assist in laying mulch along the Nature Center trails. *Tools and gloves are provided.*
